

# Direct objects

## Grade 5 Grammar Worksheet

The **direct object** is the person or thing that receives the action in a sentence.

To find the direct object:

1. Find the verb (action word).
2. Ask "What?" or "Whom?"
3. The answer is the direct object.

Example: Jacob eats three cookies

1. The verb is **eats**.
2. Eats what? → three cookies
3. **Three cookies** is the direct object.

Example: The cat chased the mouse

1. The verb is **chased**.
2. Chased what? → the mouse
3. **The mouse** is the direct object.
