When we **contrast** two things, we tell how they are **different**.


Read about the two characters:

Meet Grant! Grant is a second grade student who loves basketball. He also loves to read, and he likes telling jokes. He has brown hair and brown eyes. He is the tallest boy in his class! When Grant grows up, he wants to be President. He likes helping people, and he thinks he could help lots of people that way.



Meet Leah! Leah is a second grade student who loves to swim. She also loves to read, and she likes watching cartoons. She has black hair and blue eyes. Leah is the tallest girl in her class! When Leah grows up, she wants to be a teacher. She likes helping people and she thinks she could help lots of people that way.
